WELCOME TO THE 16th NATIONAL AUDIO VISUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

**From the Chairman of NAVC Organising Committee
Peter Brown ARPS DPAGB Hon. PAGB**

It is my pleasure to welcome you to the Premier Inn at Braunstone Town Leicestershire for the 16th National AV Championships. A new venue again for the championships, since leaving Sutton Bonington we have not been able to find a permanent suitable venue that will enable us to continue holding the championships there.

As you are aware the organising committee took the bold step to move to the 1400 x 1050 for projection. We were asked 'why have you done this, all other AV festivals are 1024 x 768', technology marches on apace, some one has to take the first step forward, and we believe it should be the major events that lead the way, and not the clubs, otherwise it would be like 'the tail wagging the dog'. The PAGB has generously loaned us their new projector and a laptop, I have seen this projector in action onto a 12ft screen and I have to say I was most impressed, I hope that you will be also.

We received an excellent entry of 73, which created more overall time that we could squeeze into the four planned projection sessions. Once again the committee had to think and act quickly, and decided that we would have to pre-select the entries. The three of us have generated enough experience in AV over the past 30 years, to know what is up to National exhibition standard. We spent considerable time viewing the entries so as to remove only those not up to 'Nationals' standards and to fit our time schedule.

We thank you for supporting us either by entering and/or attending in an attempt to make this event a success. Last January when the person responsible for the technical side of the event resigned, it created a very difficult decision for Brian and I; do we try and organise an event planned for 140 miles north or do we find a suitable venue on our doorstep. Graham Neville agreed to take on the responsibility of the technical side, and the Premier Inn fitted our needs as a venue, so here we are today. We the organising committee hope that those of you who have attended the festival enjoy it, should you have any complaints please tell us now, don't let everyone read about them in AV News, when it is too late for us to try and rectify them.

John's interest in photography goes back as long as he can remember. He shares his love of photography with a love of wild places. His camera has taken him throughout the mountains of North Wales, The Lakes and Scotland to the greater ranges of The Himalaya, The Andes, The Atlas and The Sierra. Along the way John has gained a deep respect for the culture and people who inhabit these mountain areas and has strived to capture images of them. John is never happier than when he is wandering his home mountains of Wales trying to capture 'Magical Light'. He is also a member of the The Royal Photographic Society. He was awarded his ARPS in 2004 and his DPAGB 2005. Both of these were in AV. John's philosophy in AV is " If I can communicate in a single shot what I want to say then that is sacrosanct, AV takes over when I can not.

Howard Gregory

From early teenage onwards he has dabbled in photography – monochrome, cine and 35mm. In 1975 he returned to his native North West. Sharing an office with two photographers, he bought his first SLR and was soon onto the committee of the firm's photographic society. It was here, in the early '80s, that he first saw A-V and realised the possibilities of enhancing his sound programmes with pictures. He was a regular speaker at the Platt Chapel A-V days, and eventually one of the four founder members of the Wilmslow Guild A-V Group.



He and his partner Suzanne were recording, editing and mixing soundtracks digitally well before domestic computers were fitted with soundcards, let alone CD drives. He has written over 200 articles for magazines, and, in 2006 was awarded the Dobson Henry medal for services to A-V. He is looking forward to learning from his fellow judges and will be looking for a well-structured sequence that communicates clearly, and listening for a well-recorded and structured soundtrack of a quality commensurate with the pictures.

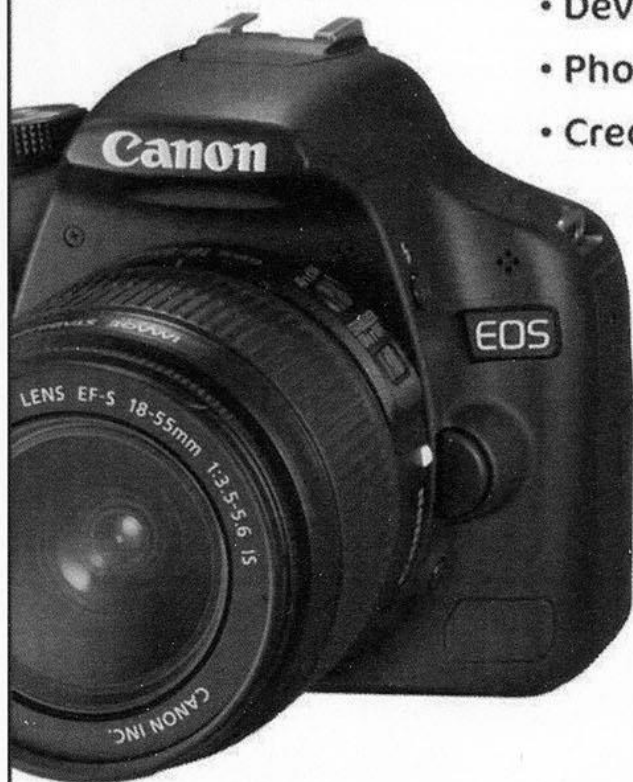
