

NAVC 2015: Venue

The venue for the 2015 Championships is the Ruxton Theatre of Staffordshire University ([Staffordshire University, Stafford, Staffordshire ST18 0AD](#)).



There is good, plentiful and **free parking** immediately outside the faculty. This is a modern university block, with an attractive, light and airy foyer, which will be our welcoming space. We will use this area for tea/coffee in the breaks and also for **light buffet lunches**, should you wish to partake.



The theatre seats around 120 in tiered, comfortable seats, all giving an excellent view of the roughly 15 feet wide screen. There are no steps between the car park and the theatre and there are a number of seats at ground level.



NAVC 2015: Entering/Attending

Entering

For the first time in the Championships, we are encouraging the entry of both AV sequences and **also film/videos**. You can enter up to two sequences where you are the author or co-author. Entry costs £10 per AV sequence/film.

The entries will be projected at full HD, i.e. 1920 x 1080, but entries with other formats will be accepted. See the rules to be clear about what and how you enter.

Entries can be sent (closing date 28th July), either as a disc to Howard Bagshaw, 9 Haywood Heights, Little Haywood, Staffs ST18 0UR, or to Howard electronically using [WeTransfer](#). In each case you need to send the entry(s) and entry form(s). Payment can be by cheque, or by bank transfer (details on the entry form)

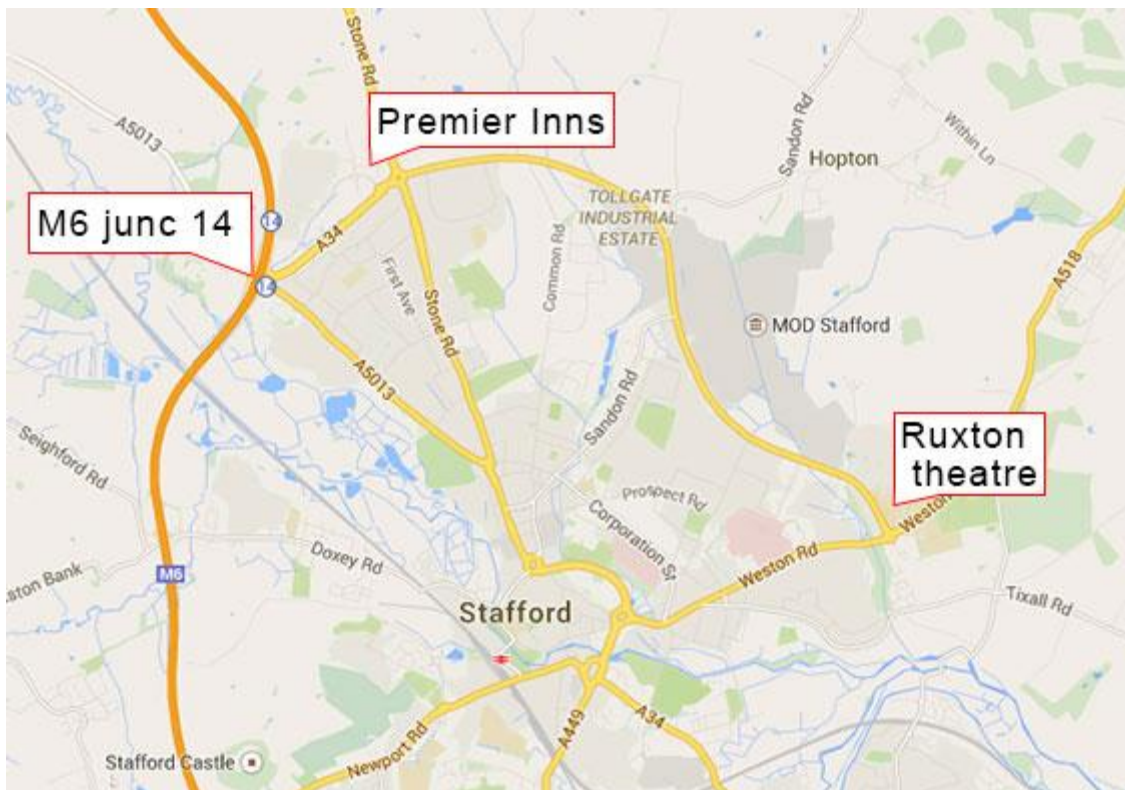
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Attending



The Championships are being run this year at a new venue, the Ruxton Theatre, on the Stafford Campus of Staffordshire University ([Staffordshire University, Stafford, Staffordshire ST18 0AD](#)). This will provide an excellent theatre to show the AVs/films.

Have a look at the full programme in the tab alongside for all the details, but we are planning for either having a 'Wildcard' session for the audience to 'bring back' sequences which have selected-out if there are a lot of entries. Alternatively we will put on a programme of AV/film activities if we get fewer entries.



On Saturday and Sunday we will have projection sessions in the morning and afternoon (with coffee/tea breaks) where these entries will be judged. A buffet lunch will be available in the foyer of the theatre, or you can do a quick trip down to the nearby pub.

We have no organised meal on Friday evening, but there are two restaurants/pubs associated with the Premier Inns, and a Chinese restaurant in easy walking distance. There are many restaurants in Stafford.

Accommodation

Unlike previous Championships, but in line with the 'Great Northern' and the 'IAC Peter Coles', we are leaving you to sort out your own accommodation.

There is a lot of accommodation in Stafford, but we are suggesting a Premier Inn, which is a very short distance from junction 14 of the M6 motorway. There are two hotels of this chain close together, we would suggest the **Premier Inn Stafford North (Spitfire)**, but the Premiere Inn Stafford North (Hurricane) is only across the road. These hotels are a short, 3 mile, drive along the ring road to the University (allow 10 mins).

We are not having a 'posh' Gala Dinner, but we have booked tables, and the bar afterwards, for a **Saturday evening meal** at the Brewer's Fayre Redhill restaurant, which is alongside the Premiere Inn.
